- Ensure inventory is priortised with considerations of margin, customer, and demand variability.

- Support inventory planning and budget forecasting working cross functionally with Finance, DC and Merchandising
- Lead territory WSSI management on weekly, monthly and quarterly basis within merchandising, ensuring risks and opportunities highlighted with key stakeholders
- Manage and control the IWT process in line with KPI's. You will also support the recalls process to
 ensure that targets and option level priorities are met
- Lead the seamless flow of stock from wholesale to retail channels, communicating with key stakeholders ensuring all stock is utilised
- Optimise clearance deals through planning of recalls alongside Merchandising

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- Proactively manage 1 to 5's and low stocks considering DC capacity and overall sku counts
- Support triangle meetings on a weekly basis, reviewing forecasts, highlighting additional workstreams across Retail, Merchandising and the DC
- Own and maintain inventory reports and dashboards for visibility of inventory, you will also be a stock systems expert in mining data for inventory role ups / analytics
